

Canada Trademarks

Bibliographic, administrative and legal information on Canadian trademarks.

- All active and many inactive trademarks that were either applied-for or registered pursuant to the current Trade-marks Act or former trademark legislation
- All cancelled, expunged, abandoned or refused trademarks after 1979 including some prior to 1979
- Words and designs which are not by definition trademarks, but that are protected by the Trade-marks Act or other related legislation; these are prohibited trademarks for which public notice has been given pursuant to Section 9 of the Trade-marks Act
- Plant variety denominations granted pursuant to the Plant Breeders' Rights Act
- Symbols and Badges of the Boy Scouts of Canada and the Girl Guides of Canada
- Trademarks of the Royal Canadian Legion
- Geographical indications for wines and spirits which have been entered on the list or for which protection has been sought.

Note: The Nice Classification is not obligatory for Canada. CIPO generates the classes via an equivalence table between the Goods & Services and Classes 1 through 42. Therefore a search of Classes 43, 44 and 45 will not produce any results.
