Examples: D0505495

**Specifications on some search fields:**

- Design Number:
  - o Any multiple designs in a single application are broken into 1 record per design, sharing a single parent number in the format x number of digits – y number of digits, where “x” is the parent design number and “y” is an incremental suffix number, also called child.
  - o Prior to September 2004, the Spanish IP law allowed two types of applications for industrial designs: Industrial models, numbered as lxxxxxx with a 7 digit number (e.g. I0119307), and Industrial Drawings, numbered as Dxxxxxx with 7 digit number (e.g. D0019790). The single concept of an Industrial Design is observed since then, with Industrial Designs numbered as Dxxxxxx-yy (e.g. D0500221-01) where “x” is a seven digit and “y” is a 2 digit corresponding to a sequence number of child designs in a multiple design application. For consistency we have indexed these as Dxxxxxx-yyyy.

**Remarks:** For a comprehensive search of all industrial designs having effect in Spain, we recommend a search covering **SPAIN, EUROPE** and **INTERNATIONAL** registers.
