WODESIGN contains all models and designs filed under the 1960 Act from number 1, filed on 01/07/79 and published on 20/09/79, models and designs under the 1934 Act, published from 01/01/86 or renewed between 1980 and 1985, as well as International registrations governed by the 1999 Act.

The information covered is taken from the International Bulletin of Models and Designs (IBMD), including renewals, extensions and entries in the International Registry.

The reproduction images are available for designs published since May 28, 2004, except for designs governed exclusively by the 1934 Act because reproductions are not published.

Images can be displayed using interfaces:

- QWEB and QWEB 2 which allow viewing of all the reproductions available for one design
- Imagination Internet which allows viewing of the first reproduction of a design

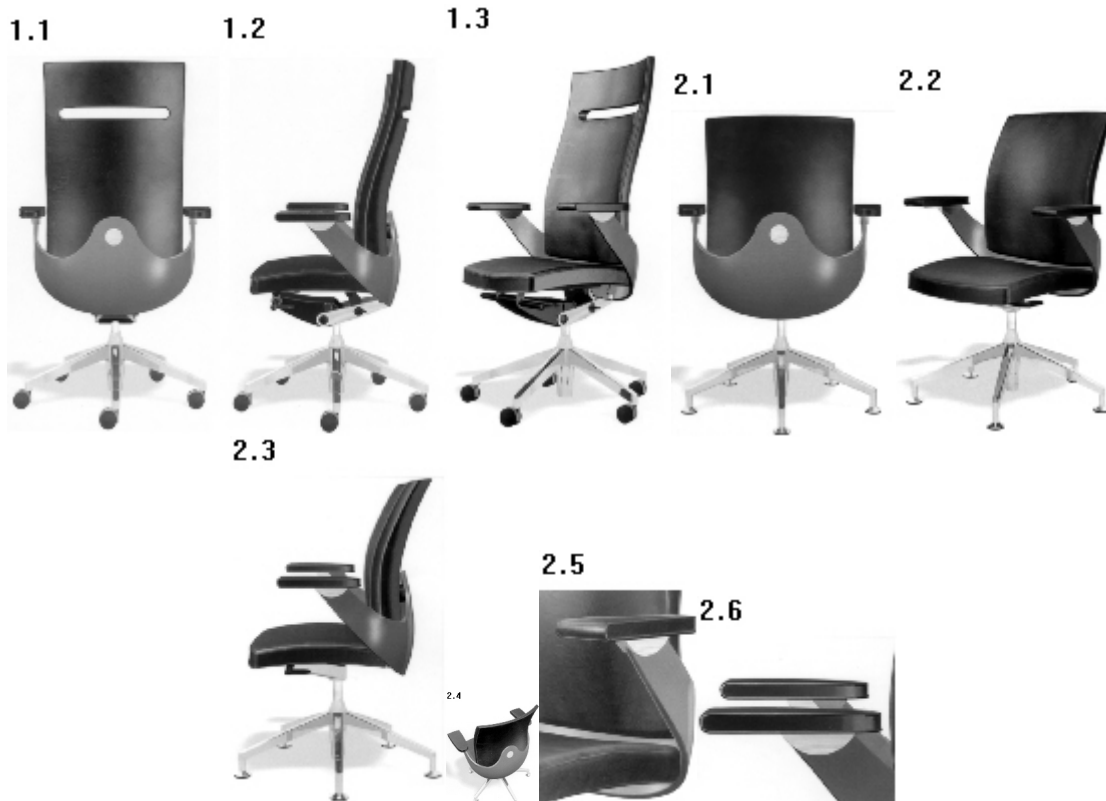

Information about International Models and Designs

The international registration grants applicants protection in 42 countries and is governed by The Hague Agreement of November 6 1925. It was then revised in London in 1934 (1934 Act) and in The Hague in 1960 (1960 Act), and again in Geneva in 1999 (1999 Act).

The international registration's aim is to provide protection for one or several industrial models or designs in several states by allowing the filing of a single application at the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) in Geneva, Switzerland.

Publications

The publication of international registrations is effected under one or other of the following two headings: "International Registrations Resulting from International Applications Governed Exclusively or Partly by the 1999 Act and/or the 1960 Act" and "International Registrations Resulting from International Applications Governed Exclusively by the 1934 Act".

In the case of international registrations resulting from international applications governed exclusively or partly by the 1999 Act and/or the 1960 Act, reproductions of the designs are also published in this Bulletin. If the international registration includes more than one design, each of them is identified by a different number. Where the same industrial design is represented from different angles, the numbering consists of two figures separated by a dot (e.g. 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, etc., for the first industrial design; 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, etc., for the second industrial design; and so on).

In the case of international registrations resulting from international applications governed exclusively by the 1934 Act, there is no provision for publication of reproductions of the designs.

Copies of models or designs not covered in the IBMD may be requested from WIPO.

Term of protection

International registration is effected for an initial period of five years following the date of international registration and may be renewed for two additional five-year periods before each of those periods expires. Subject to renewal, the maximum duration of protection in each designated Contracting Party is thus 15 years following the date of international registration.

Moreover, if the national legislation of a Contracting Party provides for a duration of protection in excess of 15 years for designs filed for registration by the national route, the international registration may be renewed with respect to that Contracting Party for additional periods of five years up to the expiry of the total duration of protection provided for in its national legislation.
