Family Searching

After having entered a FAM command in the FamPat or PlusPat databases, you may display the patent family and corresponding legal status information without entering the LGST database. By using the FAMSTAT(E) display option, the LGST data will automatically display with the patent family data. In FamPat and PlusPat databases, an additional display option is available: MFAMSTAT(E). For further information, see the FamPat or PlusPat Fact Sheets.

Current Awareness Alerts - SDIs

It is possible to create SDIs on the LGST database. Update codes can now be linked to the addition of each new status actions. SDIs may be run on a weekly (default) or monthly basis.
